

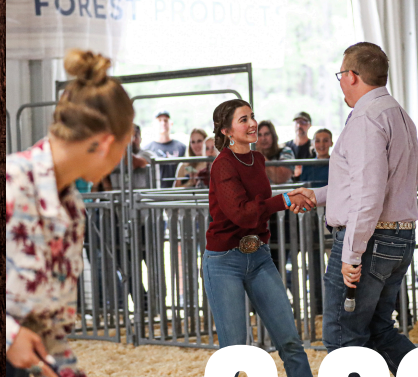

PURPOSE OF THE AUCTION

The purchase of an auction animal provides a two-fold benefit to encourage junior exhibitors. The immediate benefit is to motivate 4-H exhibitors to learn and excel in the business of raising and fitting their animals. Proceeds from the sale of projects often fund college educations, enhancing the ability of these youth to contribute to their communities.



As a buyer, your participation in the sale recognizes youth for the time, expense, and effort that has gone into raising an animal for market. When you purchase a market animal from a Junior Livestock exhibitor, you're buying home-grown, high-quality, and flavorful meat. Your support of the Junior Livestock Auction also benefits the NAJLA Scholarship Program, which aids students in pursuing their undergraduate degrees.

Please support the Junior Livestock Auction and invest in the youth of Coconino County 4-H.



HOW TO PARTICIPATE

All buyers must register prior to making a bid* at the auction. Registered buyers will receive a buyer number and auction program. All buyers must fill out a Buyer's Agreement Form. Our auction volunteers will help you every step of the way.

1

HOME-USE

An individual may purchase an animal at the auction by placing the winning bid. Your bid price is the amount you pay for the animal. Your designated processor will process the meat. Processing costs are in addition to the purchase cost.

2

SPLIT-BUYING

Form a team of business associates, friends, or neighbors to purchase an animal and divide it between your team members

3

RE-SALE

If you do not wish to keep the meat for personal use, you will pay the bid price and donate the animal back for re-sale at the end of the auction. The re-sale value will go to the Northern Arizona Junior Livestock Association. This provides financial assistance in promoting and conducting the auction, other livestock events, and scholarships.

4

ADD-ONS

Minimum amount of \$25 to one or more exhibitors.

PROCESSING

THROUGH ARIZONA MOBILE MEAT



All livestock processed by Arizona Mobile Meat Processing will be dispatched at their facility located in Williams Arizona, unless otherwise noted. State Inspected livestock will be available (except for poultry) but only upon request prior to animal pick up. Additional fees may apply.

After completing your purchase at the auction, you will proceed to the NAJLA checkout table where you may select Arizona Mobile Meat Processing as your processor.

Arizona Mobile Meat Processing will contact you within a week from animal pick up to complete your custom processing instructions. Once processing is complete, you will be contacted with a date of delivery & location, or you will have the option to come and pick up your meat at our facility.

Beef	\$125 dispatch, \$1.25/lb hanging weight
Swine	\$375 harvest, cut, wrapped. Includes 2 hams, 2 bacons and up to 20lbs of bulk sausage. Additional sausage starts at \$3.00/lb
Lamb/Goat	\$155 Standard Processing
Fryer Pen of 3	\$50.00
Turkey	\$50.00

PAYMENT

Please proceed to the check-out table to complete your purchase. Payment options include cash, check, or credit card (3% transaction fees).

Payment is due in full by the end of the auction.
